LCV Building Entrance



LCI Language School is conveniently located on the first floor of Lasalle College Vancouver, offering easy access to students and visitors.

LCV Reception



The reception area is staffed with personnel who can guide you to various departments, including the language school. Security staff are also present to ensure student safety and prevent unauthorized access.

LCI Language School Entrance



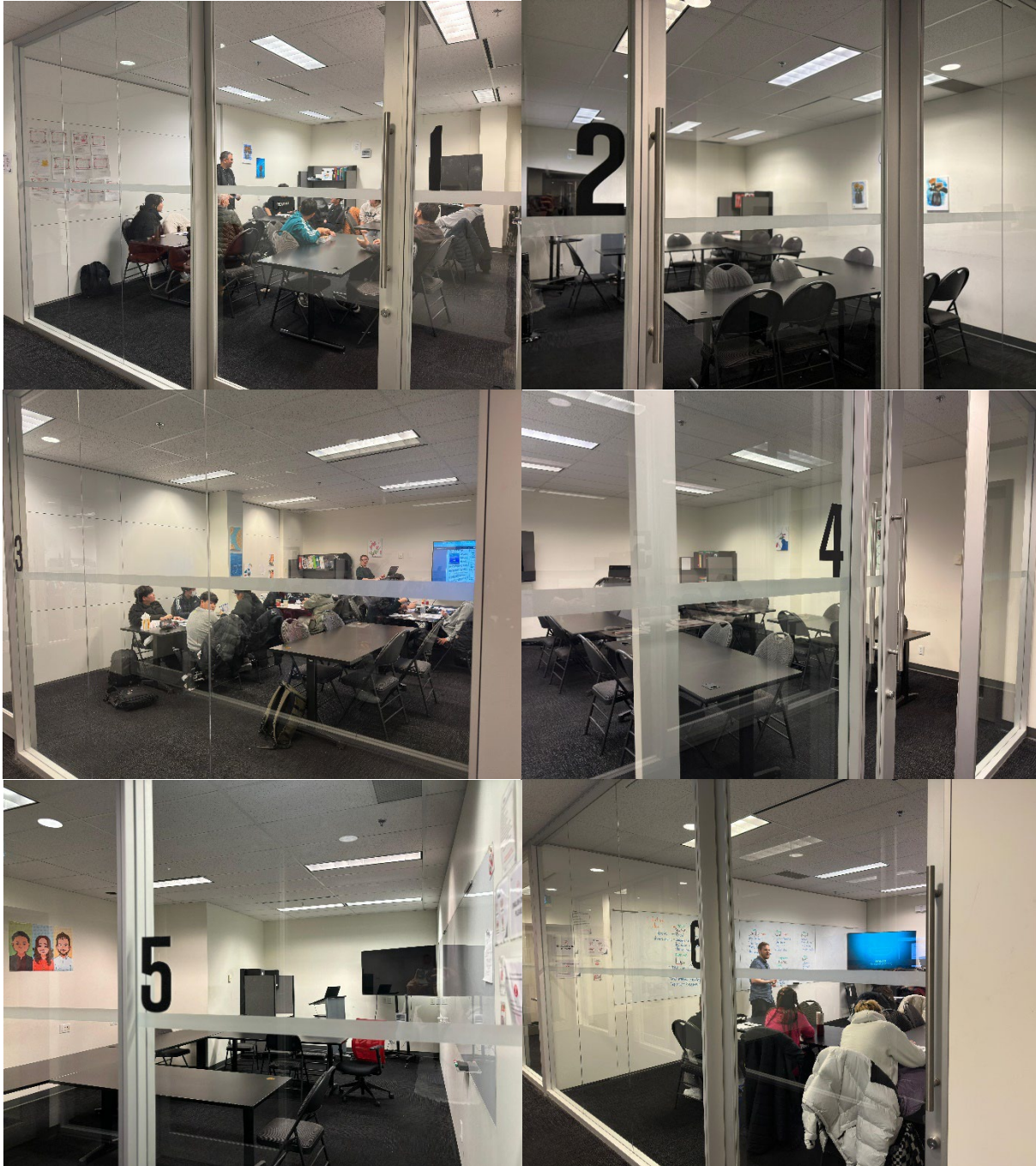
The entrance to LCI Language School is located on the left side of the first floor.

Classrooms



LCI Language School has six classrooms. During periods of high enrollment, additional classrooms from the college are also utilized.

Front Desk



Front desk staff are available from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to support students with various needs, such as vacation requests, program upgrades, extensions, purchasing medical insurance, counseling, study plans, and information sessions.

Student Lounge



The lounge features bean bags, cozy sofas, and Jenga for students to relax and socialize. Class lists are posted every Monday, and activity lists every Wednesday on the student board in the lounge. The lounge also hosts breaktime mixers and Thursday graduation events.



Each student receives a personalized mug to use while at school. Mugs are hung on the mug wall and returned upon graduation. The photo wall showcases memories of past activities and student life at LCI Language School.



Volunteer students prepare coffee and tea for others. Students can use their own mugs and have access to a table, fridge, and microwaves for storing and heating meals.

Student Computers



Two computers are available for students to work on assignments or presentations. The hallway also features the activity calendar.

First floor washrooms



Washrooms are located next to the language school entrance.

Cafeteria



The cafeteria is run by friendly Korean staffs offering coffee, beverages, muffins, sandwiches, cookies, and Korean dishes.



The cafeteria provides ample seating, microwaves, vending machines, and a pool table for student use.

Bookstore



The bookstore offers a variety of stationery, art materials for college programs, female hygiene products, and LCI souvenirs.

Back Washrooms



Additional washrooms are available near the bookstore and cafeteria.

Kitchen for Cooking Activity



Located on the second floor, this kitchen is used for cooking activities. Students have the opportunity to use the same facilities as baking program students, guided by a college instructor.

PS5 Gaming Area



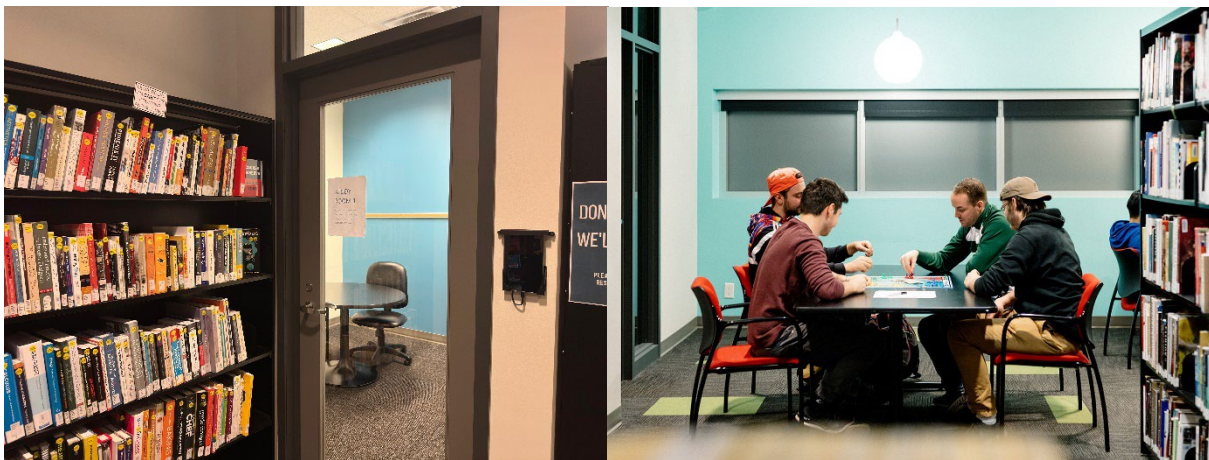
A PS5 gaming station is available for students. Games can be borrowed from the library, and reservations are required.

Library



Open until 11:00 p.m., the library provides a quiet space for study and research.

The library offers a wide selection of books, including resources for college art majors.



Study rooms are available for group projects or tutoring sessions upon reservation, Desks and chairs are available for individual study.

Second Floor Bistro



The bistro hosts bake sales and open events where culinary students serve meals. These events often support donation initiatives and offer affordable bakery items.

Student Life Board



Located near the library, this board provides information on upcoming events and contact details. Most college events are open to language school students.

Vit D Lounge



This large open area near the main entrance features foosball and ping-pong tables (equipment available at reception with a student ID). It is also used for large gatherings, orientations, or classrooms during high intake periods.

Counseling Rooms



Cozy rooms are available for private counseling sessions in a quiet environment.
